Description: This violin has a two-piece maple back showing strong medium figure descending from the center joint. The sides and neck are of similar material. The front is of two pieces of spruce showing fine grain becoming very slightly broader towards the edges. The fittings are of ebony. The varnish is of a dark red colour over a yellow ground and is in very good condition with some scratches and original antiquing apparently by the maker. There are no cracks or repairs.

Back measurements:

Length: 357 mm. Upper bout: 167 mm. Middle bout: 113 mm. Lower bout: 209 mm.
